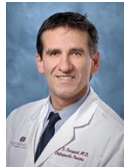




Guy D. Paiement, MD

Guy D. Paiement, MD, is a board-certified orthopaedic surgeon and Founding Director of the Orthopaedic Residency Program at Cedars Sinai Medical Center. His primary clinical interests are adult joint reconstruction and orthopaedic trauma. Dr Paiement's research is mainly focused on infection, biomechanics and gait analysis.

Dr Paiement has been a guest lecturer, chairing dozens of courses and conferences in a wide variety of subjects relating to orthopaedics. He is the winner of several research and teaching awards, including the Otto Aufranc Research Award, the General Motor Trauma Award, the Clinical Faculty Teaching Award from the University of California, Irvine and the James M. Morris Memorial Award from the University of California, San Francisco. Dr Paiement was also a Professor of Clinical Orthopaedic Surgery at both institutions.

He is a member of several professional organizations, including the American Orthopaedic Association, California Orthopaedic Association, American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons, Western Orthopedic Association, Orthopaedic Trauma Association and Council of Orthopaedic Residency Directors. He has published more than 65 articles in peer reviewed publications such as the *New England Journal of Medicine*, *Lancet*, *the American Journal of Surgery*, *the Journal of Bone and Joint Surgery* and *the Journal of Orthopaedic Trauma*. Dr Paiement also is a reviewer for many medical publications, including the *New England Journal of Medicine*, *the Journal of Orthopaedic Research and Joint Surgery*.

Dr. Paiement earns his medical degree at the Universite of Montreal, Montreal Canada, where he also performed his residency in orthopaedic surgery. He completed a research fellowship in joint replacement and biomechanics at Harvard Medical School, a joint replacement clinical fellowship at Massachusetts General Hospital, and a clinical fellowship in orthopaedic trauma from the Universite of Montreal. Dr Paiement has also earned a Master of Business Administration degree from the University of California, Irvine.
